The Summer Camp Supervisor will assist the Program Coordinators with various responsibilities to support camp operation. This is an important role that includes mentoring other instructors, evaluating camp programming, communicating with parents of participants at check in/out, and leading the start-of-day and end-of-day instructor check-ins.

## Responsibilities:

#### Office:

- Guide customers through the program sign-up process and assist them with all enquiries.
- Supervise a team of youth program instructors / guides and ensure all staff members have the info they
  require.
- Work with the Coordinators to help develop summer camp program ideas, opportunities and identify any issues.
- Supporting the Coordinators with planning and coordinating the day-to-day delivery of our summer camp programs.
- Ensure all Endless Biking resources are booked ahead of time and ready to use. (Van, Stunts, tents)
- Developing an in-depth and detailed understanding of all EB offerings including: lessons, rentals and guided rides and being able to accurately advise customers.
- Work collaboratively with other program coordinators and managers.

#### In the field:

- Guide/ instruct both youth and adult programs to the highest of standards set by Endless Biking across both Mt. Fromme, Mt. Seymour and other potential locations.
- Deliver lessons and guided rides with a range of customers from around the globe.
- Communicate with parents of youth riders to provide a positive customer experience.
- Communicate with Youth Instructors as and when required, constructively or with praise.
- Assist with the set up of registration and program staging areas.
- Participate and assist with all required Endless Biking employee training.
- Assist when needed with loading the Endless Biking vehicles in a safe and professional manner.
